GS1 SYSTEM DEPLOYMENT

This service area focuses on the effective implementation and utilisation of a specific GS1 standard. Within this offering we can provide – **education, training, and advice surrounding the implementation of a particular GS1 standard customised to your business**

This type of engagement is predominantly used by companies who require subject matter expertise in relation to their adoption (or current usage) of a GS1 standard. It does not cover the **formal** definition of business process requirements or any other implementation dependencies. It also does not cover project management support for the implementation itself. However, what this service does provide is a level of understanding and expert knowledge of the GS1 standard required to effectively utilise the standard within your business.

The GS1 standards supported in this type of engagement are:

- **GS1 Barcodes** - GS1– 13 (Also known as EAN-13), GS1 – 128, ITF – 14, Data Bar, Data Matrix, Composite Component
- **GS1 EPC Global (RFID)**
- **GS1 ECom (electronic messaging)** – GS1 EANCOM, GS1 XML
- **GS1 Traceability**

Benefits included – Provides you with the required knowledge of the GS1 standard to ensure it is utilised correctly, hence maximising the benefit realised.

The focus is on automation of internal and inter-company transactions utilising automatic data capture (ADC) and electronic messaging automation enablers.

The scope of the assessment can be on one or more of the following generic functional areas: **Inwards Goods, Production, Outward Goods, Distribution, Sell Side Business Transactions, and Buy Side Business Transactions**

GS1 SUPPLY CHAIN ENHANCEMENT PROGRAM

GS1 standards & supporting solutions can deliver benefits to all disciplines within a supply chain. The GS1 team has extensive experience in best practice business processes and enabling technology solutions. These two factors have resulted in the development of a program to support companies that are looking to deliver enhancements within their supply chain. The program comprises four related but optional phases that cover an entire implementation lifecycle. These are listed below including the key deliverables from each phase.

Phase 1: Analysis & Recommendation: Broad/Thin Assessment, Business Process Analysis, Hardware & Software Assessment, Recommendation Overview, and Implementation Approach Overview

Phase 2: Prioritisation & Solution Definition: Initiative Definition, Initiative Prioritisation, Business Case Development, RFP Development, and Proposal Evaluation

Phase 3: Implementation Program Development: Project Initiation Documents, Project Planning, and Change Management Approach recommendations

Phase 4: Implementation Program Deployment: Project Management, Change Management, 3rd Party Management, and Subject Matter Expertise

The types of GS1 supported enablers that will be utilised within the enhancement initiatives of this program are:

Supply Chain Data Integrity - The ability to efficiently interpret accurate information throughout the supply chain.

Data Synchronisation - The concept of continuously sharing master data surrounding your products with your trading partners to help ensure data integrity and allow for a more efficient & effective supply chain.

Automatic Identity & Data Capture - The ability to capture rich information at traditional transaction points or new collection points that are free of error and expend minimal effort

Supply Chain Visibility - The ability to have visibility surrounding the movement of goods through-out the greater supply chain.

Traceability - The ability to be able to efficiently and effectively provide traceability of products to each supply chain entity up and down the supply chain to the point of consumer consumption.

Transaction Automation - The ability to automate transactions conducted with your trading partners, utilising electronic messaging and associated system integration

Supply Chain Collaboration - The ability to enable scaleable enhanced collaboration with your trading partners relating to information sharing and collaborative decision making.

These enablers deliver key benefits within the supply chain. Some of these areas are listed below: Demand Planning, Supplier Performance, Material Requirement Planning, Inventory Management, Production Planning, Order Accuracy, Working Capital Direct Resource Overhead, Space Utilisation, Transaction Errors, Transport Logistics, DFOT Performance, Customer Service, Credits, Invoice Matching, ... In fact the list could go on and on and serves to illustrate that benefits that can be delivered in nearly all supply chain disciplines and interrelated functions by utilising GS1 standards & solutions

Cost:

The cost involved in each of the phases will be dependent on the business process scope, your company's operational landscape, and the role GS1 will fulfil. Based on our previous engagements you might expect between \$4,000 and \$15,000 for each of the first three phases.
