## Starting Strong

### 2005

- Global GS1 Healthcare User Group (HUG) is formed
- The National E-Health Transition Authority (NEHTA) in Australia chose to use GS1 standards



### 2006 & 2007

- GS1 signs memorandums of understanding with two other Standards Developing Organisations (SDOs), HL7 and ICCBBA.
- Eucomed position paper recommending implementation of GS1 published



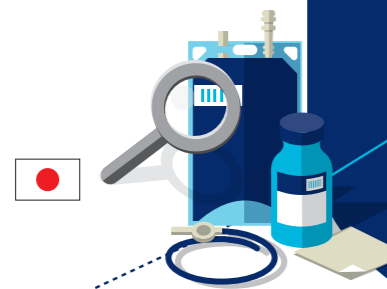
### 2008 & 2009

- The Institute for Safe Medication Practices Canada (ISMP) and Canadian Patient Safety Institute (CPSI) endorse the adoption of GS1 standards
- First GS1 Healthcare Reference Book published
- Three global GS1 Healthcare conferences held per annum



### 2011

- The EU Falsified Medicines Directive Released
- Argentinian National Drug Traceability programme using GS1 standards goes live



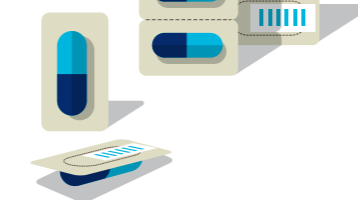
### 2012

- 99% of medical devices supply in Japan identified with a GTIN
- McKinsey report "Strength in Unity" published



### 2013

- GS1 first accredited UDI issuing agency for the US FDA UDI rule



### 2018

- First global GS1 Healthcare African Conference in Addis Ababa, Ethiopia
- New 2018-22 Healthcare strategy released
- Regulatory Roadmap: Traceability of Medicinal Products is published



### 2017

- Recommendation for GS1 standards by USAID and UNFPA
- New GS1 standard for Basic UDI-UDI based on the Medical Devices Regulation (MDR) and In-vitro Diagnostics Regulation (IVDR) published
- Asia Pacific Economic Cooperation (APEC) Roadmap on supply chain integrity and drug safety released



### 2016

- Increased focus on working with healthcare providers through Project Imagine
- Implementation kit for EDI standards in healthcare published



### 2015

- WHO preferred vaccine characteristics include the presence of a barcode that "should conform to GS1 standards"
- GS1 holds the 27<sup>th</sup> GS1 Healthcare conference in Mexico City



### 2014

- Healthcare GTINs in GDSN exceed 1 million (33% growth in 1 year)
- The Danish Minister states "all Danish hospitals in the future have to use GS1 standards"
- The UK Department of Health eProcurement strategy mandates GS1 standards



### 2019

- Traceability call to action signed in Lagos by 25 African regulatory bodies
- GS1 designated as UDI issuing entity for the EU MDR/IVDR
- First Clinical Trials standard for investigational products

### 2020

- GS1 Healthcare participates at World Economic Forum in Davos
- Chair of Joint Initiative Council
- Over 3 million Healthcare GTINs in GDSN (May 2020)
